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If you take $\cos 45^{\circ}(14.5^{\circ})$ you get 10.25° . And if you take $(10.25^{\circ}/11)$ inv \cos you get 21.28° That gives a mouth of 12.5° x 25° . Using 11° as the top and bottom with $3/4^{\circ}$ wood and 12° x 24° mouth, the depth is 11.09° , that s close enough, so this is how I'll build them. I'll begin cutting wood on monday. Regards Kim
