nice flat response curve. It's just that the efficiency is much higher, providing lots of dynamic

range, so midrange is sweet and pure. Voices sound natural, as do other instruments like cello and piano that are so hard to get right. The -3dB point is 35Hz, so these speakers deliver unusually deep bass response too. The tweeter is crisp, but not unnaturally so.
