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I'm nearing completion of my Theater Seven Pi corner speakers, and I'm wondering about positioning in my listening room. The room is approximately 14 by 18. Do I position the speakers on the shorter wall, and have the "Throne" at a direct 45 degree angle from each speaker? Does it matter if I sit further back from this "convergence point"? If I put them in the corners on the long side of the room, the 45 degrees from each one approximately coincides with a seat in the middle of the opposite wall. If it's the other way, it's more in the middle of the room. Any Suggestions?? I know you'd never place conventional speakers this far apart, but they stick out quite aways from the corners.Ed White

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
