However, after stumbling on this driver on Partsexpress (see link below), it seems quite affordable. According to the specs, it looks like a light version of the Lab-12. It models almost exactly like a Lab-12. Probably made by Eminence. Wayne, any thoughts on this driver? Also, can you provide me with more background on designing a push-pull sub, or point me to some links. Googling has turned up very little. Would cabinet size be double that of a single driver box? If so, that would make the cabinet 6 to 7 cu ft, and far too big for most home use. What about driver mounting? I don't think I want to see the back of a driver sticking out of the front baffle. Can drivers be mounted front baffle/ back baffle? thx, Gar.
