I have gotten significant improvements in One Pi and Two Pi speakers by going to slightly higher values in the coil (from .5 to .6 or .7 mh) and more importantly going to a higher gauge coil. In my case I got 14 gauge coils, though close is probably good enough. Parts express handles them. I also am using some motor-run caps on the vifa tweeters. You can get them on ebay for not too much and they are very smooth. You won't get a lot more low bass, but the mid-bass and lower midrange open up and the highs are smoother. Skip
