I've built some smaller three-way speakers, some that I thought were quite good. But they never work as well off-axis, which means the reverberent field isn't as uniform. You can't make a small midrange with unform directivity. If it's small, it must be a direct radiator and the best you can hope for in that case is collapsing directivity that matches the tweeter at the crossover point.
