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That's the exact problem I had when looking for a tweeter for this speaker. There are few tweeters with the right characteristics. As you've seen, you need the right combination of sensitivity and frequency range. There are lots of ribbons and dome tweeters that are very nice, but most don't have the sensitivity. Of those that do, most can't be used low enough in frequency. There are some horns that fit the bill, but none had the sound I wanted for this speaker. All were really super-tweeters and just too bright. A 1" compression driver would have actually worked well,

matching with the tweeter; Without it, the crossover point would have to be made higher for matching the Alpha 10 as a direct radiator. But when I thought about it, I already have two very

much alone in my choices.

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
