With just a passive volume pot, 2 watts gets loud enough for Dire Straits but not for the Who. Loud enough for Count Basie but not the Cleveland Orchestra, w/o serious clipping. The Aikido is described by Broskie as "a 2 tube cathode follower with the first tube a vlotage divider of 50%, so that 50% of the PS noise is presented to the CFs grid; at the same time the 100k resistors also define a voltage divider of 505 so the bottom triodes grid also sees 50 % of the PS noise. Since both of these signals are equal in amplitude and phase, they cancel each other out, as each triode sees an identical increase in plate current."I have no idea what any of that means....

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
