I hope this is appropriate for this forum. Klipsch Hereseys with mangled cabinets are pretty easy to find. I have a pair and have been coveting Cornwalls for a while. Is there a way to significantly improve the Heresy with a new cabinet and woofer alignment ? The goal would be to keep the original drivers and build a larger cabinet, possibly ported, and modify the crossover to fit. The goal would be to transform the speaker from a rocker to more of an even handed smoother all rounder. Is there any info from someone who has pondered this ? I know that the original cabinet is undersized for the woofer which shifts the tuning up and works well enough. Now what if I decrease the tuning ? Will the speaker still integrate well or will there be too much group delay with a port ?
