Hi Wayne. I've been looking into upgrading my front three mains for my theater and have been looking into the Pi4 for some time now. I was wondering though if instead of the JBL midbass I could use an alternative. I have lots of interest in the TD15M from Acoustic Elengance. Seems to me that it could have superior performance to the JBL and is priced around the same. The Re is a little different so that might skew it the most. The Xmax, Fs, power handling, sensitivity are all very close. The inductance is much, much lower on this AE driver though. I provided a link to the rest of the TD series T/S specs and a picture of the frequency response of the TD15M. It is said to be very usable off axis to 2khz and on axis to 4khz. Thank you.
