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Subject: Subwoofer placing behind the listening position?

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Hi Wayne, I have read a few of your posts on multi-sub and positioning. It sounds really interesting and I am tempted to try it in the near future (when I have some spare money!). Your posts mentioned a few ways to place the subs (e.g. in 4 corners, one in a corner, other in mid-way of the wall etc). My question is, if my main speakers are placed at the two front corners already, can a sub (or two subs) be placed behind the listening position at the corners with low low-pass frequency? It sounds very different to what most 'audiophile' would do. I have a very narrow room so there is no space for subs close to the front wall. I have always find that getting good bass is very difficult and 90% of the time my listening position is at an anti-node for some bass frequency. I have used some DIY bass trap which helps a bit but not enough, and they are huge and ugly. So I am really keen to try other solutions.

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
