"I would trust that Hornresp is giving you an accurate prediction of SPL and of amplitude response, at least at the lower end of the curve" The curve of the 93dB driver is a bit higher all over the spectrum, and the strongest frequency is 300Hz. Would you trust this and order that driver? It also got higher EBP (although lower f_s) and lower mass. About Q_{ms} then, when I try to evaluate a driver (for any type of box), a larger value is better, as long as Q_{ts} is kept within range? Thanks much WayneAdam
