It had theworst slap echo I've ever heard. One rug on each side did a great job. The upside is that a good looking rug is a decorative element. Youdon't have to scheme to camouflage the treatment while not compromising its effectiveness.I suspect that you might get a little more attenuation due to the kinetic effect of pressure waves moving the rug, however slightly, at the lower frequncies.
