check internal standing wave modes. One of the most common problems I see with tower configurations is internal standing waves lining up in an unfavorable way and causing response anomalies. When you make a tower, the positions of woofer and port become somewhat critical. This is true for any large speaker with a midwoofer used through the midrange, but even more so with towers.
