I also like the newer bands of John Fedchock, Bob Minzer and Rob McConnell. Maynard Ferguson is still touring to high schools and small venues. A rare find of his called "The Waltz" I managed to find in the statewide library collection. That goes through my head on a daily basis for _years_. We've covered the swing and pop scene but we haven't touched the classical or ska or folk scene hardly at all.
