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You can connect two speakers on one channel, provided the amplifier minimum impedance is

because then the impedance would be below the minimum.

Another thing to consider though is there is usually little to be gained from doing this. Except in prosound, where you need a lot of SPL, you can generally get better results using a single speaker for each channel. Put your money in a good speaker that does what you want it to do and use one per channel. If you want surround sound, use a processor that has surround channel outputs.

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
