One product (OT here sure, but good to pass on information) called "In The Groove" is funky as all get out to see , but works great and is cheap. It looks like a small paint roller and has a surface like a Gummy Bear (washable). It removes dust and lint like a magnet. I love it and it only costs about \$20.
