Hi Shane, Stop by sometime and hear the bass. My system uses Martin Logan ESLs for everything above 50HZ. Below that is a pair of 7 cubic foot Altec Lansing cabinets with 15 inch subs that are flat to 23 HZ. You can feel the drums just fine. It also means that everything has to be tied down or it walks away. Back to car audio.... I have heard some that are pretty good, but more frequently not. There are challenges in cars that the average home doesn't face. Size, good locations for speakers, and so on. I am amazed that any sound good. I have noticed a trend it seems.
