Miles Davis Round About Midnight Good stuff, really soulful by Davis but the best, most listenable playing I have heard from Coltrane. Freddy Cole Merry-Go-Round#1 sound. Telarc hybrid SACD. Good band, especially Lou Marini best known by me for the Blues Brothers playing on the lunch counter at Aretha's Cafe. Cole's renditions of classics like Smoke Gets In Your Eyes and It's Impossible are very evocative of his brother but the interpretations more modern. Have to admit these are easy, rather than challenging to listen to. But then I've always been easy.
