I'm not familiar with the input options of digital amps, but are there any that can take the digital-out from a CDP directly, thereby, bypassing the D/A of the CDP and the A/D of the amp? What about digital crossovers? Can they operate entirely in the digital domain (ie. digital input from CDP and digital out to amp). Gar.
