Can't tell if you are spelling Spondor when you spell sendors. I have lot of experience with Spondors and still think they are one of the most musical speakers ever. Try Waynes site, the Pi speakers work perfectly with tube amps and sound great and priced very reasonable. But if you are committed to the Sendors I can attest that they all work well with tube amps, very flat impedance curve consequently easy load for tubes. 20 watts should suffice unless you are a headbanger then you should not even consider the Spondors anyway. Waynes Pi 2's do it all with tubes try them. Spondors sound best on Classical music not so fine on rock or pop. The Totem Arro's don't have great rep with tubes according to common knowledge.
