Even PS for the preamp & EQ was transistors regulated, +/- 10V, BC141/BC161...Then 10-band VU-meter with LEDs, I don`t remember what IC...Sorry, I was young - it happened almost 25 years ago...Anyway, I`m glad that I had a chance to confess it here, bye...

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
