"For SET amps, you can reduce the number of resistors... There is no harm having them, but as long as the power stays low, no heat is generated, and no damage to the resistors even if you only use one per R1/R2 leg."

The Xovers are built for the B&C DE250 & JBL 2226HPL, 80hms driver combination. I am handy with a soldering iron. Hope you can help. Thanks!
