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That's too bad if they can't be refurbished as survivors but good on you for even investigating it and not directly abandoning the notion.

If it shakes-out that way, here are my ideas:

- 1) Beg Wayne for 3-pi thermionic design. Do quickie qtr-wave sims using ewave woofer data. If no showstoppers, whack new baffle to put driver and port where he had them. Stick ewave guts in new baffle. Don't push a bunch of watts but just test-listen (and see how much "bigger" your ewave can sound). Worst case, put your ewave guts back where they were, out one pair of baffle's work but prepped for re-baffling.
- 2) Beg Wayne for ancient 4-pi thermionic design :) Obtain remaining parts and make new baffles.
- 3) Lots of other stuff...depending on what you want. 5+ ft3 is a nice cab to have. And it's built Well :) I really like those cabs. Heck--I'll do the sims if somebody tells me where the old designs had driver and port relative to overall cab dims (is that a dc300?).
