Darkened just a little bit, and remained smooth. I think I did an intermediate pass with 600-grit after a few days of oil application. Still on the hunt for Southern Live-Oak. I visited a woodcraft store, and saw some neat stuff. Yellowheart. Mustard yellow and fine grain.
