I remember reading a post some years ago that made a lot of sense to me.Instead of soldering all of the connections, this guy mentioned puttingthreaded brass posts in and then soldering ring tounges on the ends ofyour internal and external wires. You would then put the rings togetheron the post and clamp them with a nut. Thus, you would have a very tightconnection between the tounges, the posts would not be in the circuit and you could change things around fairly easily. Not as convenient asRCAs and conventional binding posts, but still quick, cheap, with an essentially guaranteed contact quality.
