I have both fours and sevens, both with JBL woofers. The hybrid 4/7 is basically the same thing whole reason a person opts for the 4/7 hybrid is they don't have the corners. Then position becomes much more of a variable. The more radiating angle you have to cover, the more compromised the bass and lower mids are. So corners is best, back against a wall is second best. I wouldn't pull them out into open space.
