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The KAPPA PRO 12" has an  $f_s=37\text{Hz}$ , lower 10Hz from the 15", and higher  $X_{\text{max}}$  of 4.8mm vs. 3.2mm for the 15" what's good also. It is also possible to use the software PiAlign (by Wayne) that may give very good designs for DIY and is not difficult to learn.

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
