A group build project is one where somebody has done the design work and built a prototype, then the project information is posted so anybody else can build it. In some cases a special price may have been negotiated with suppliers. For example, the parts for the Art Array project retail for about \$400, but we negotiated a wholesale price of about \$285 with Parts Express.
