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These can be picked up used for a song. They have JVC's anti jitter convertor built in, and it's switchable too. They have a built in, remote controlled 3 band parametric eq, and it is done in the digital domain! It has separate power supply caps for each of 5 channels, and in stereo, they are all paralleled for a low z with lots of reserves. The sound is NAD or B&K like, on the laid back side, with a decent image. No, it is no match for my NYAL Moscode 600 and Dared Tube line stage, but it is a nice piece, especially if you need EQ.
