I would contact Hitachi and get data sheets for the two transistors. You should be able to find compatible parts, maybe ones that exceed the original specs. Match Hfe, match or exceed Vceo and Vcbo and match or exceed Ic and Pt.I would replace both channels with matched pairs. If you can't find matched pairs, you may have to buy a small lot and measure them yourself for matching purposes.
