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Yeah, I've been to lots of clubs that sounded just like you're describing. One place I used to go a lot in Tulsa had a great band system, but in between sets, they played this nasty second system. The live sound had about 12Kw of Crown power and JBL's all around. But the secondary system was underpowered and had about twice as many piezo electric tweeters as they needed. Talk about two different sound characters! The main system sounded great, best in Tulsa. But the second system was the most hideous thing you ever heard, shrill and spitty, lots of energy in the upper midrange and treble. The place was called the Brink, and the secondary system 'bout put you over the Brink!
