Six feet (minimum) of unobstructed wall space from the corner is recommended. Also, the room dimensions should be such that the forward axes will cross in front of the listeners for best results. In other words, don't place the speakers at each side of a long wall where the listeners would sit closer to the speakers than where the axes cross.
