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These are two very different designs, almost incomparable. But they do have some notable similarities, such as spectral balance. They both work very well with low power tube amps, providing high sensitivity and a benign impedance curve. Beyond those attributes, they are pretty much fundamentally different speakers. They were designed with different goals in mind.

expanding below that. It is truly a statement speaker, one that provides best of class performance. Especially when it is outfitted with the upgraded drivers, I'm not sure there is a better "waveguide" speaker on the market. Sorry to be a little immodest, but I believe it's that good.
