Depends on what your using for recoding. For keyboards run them through a direct box. For acoustic guitar if it's acoustic/electric, direct box, or a semi-live room if the guitar's just acoustic. Vocals, I've used semi-live rooms to bathrooms. The good thing about bathrooms is you can vary the natural reverb by varying the shower doors with the right mic placement and/or where the vocalist placement is located.
