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Is there anything on or near the subwoofer? If so, the sound energy could be causing it to vibrate. You should also check to see if your subwoofer has feet that may need to be tightened, or a cable coming out of the jack.

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We had a similar problem when we first set our stereo system up in the living room. Turned out it was because the subwoofer was sitting up under a glass and metal table and the bass was causing the glass to rattle in the metal seating. Maybe something like that is what's going on in your case. Might have something to do with where your subwoofer or other speakers are sitting.
