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Hi My first thought is to go wireless...but that can cause as many problems as it solves. Some other possibilities are go through the walls to the next room and run the wires there. I have on occasion temporarily removed the base board molding strips and put the wires behind them. You can if desired put mounting plates and jacks where the wires need to come out. If the wires need to be out in open areas then sometimes you can run them under the carpet. A last resort is to use the flat rubber strips for running wires across walkways. They come in a roll of about 10-12 feet and places like Ace, Home Depot and Lowes usually have them.
