The main thing to watch out for is aftermarket recones. A factory 2226H cone will have 71649-02 stamped somewhere on the back of it. As long as the cone is OEM and the driver is in overall good shape you should be fine...I've heard it takes a lot to kill a 2226. I got mine in good condition on ebay for about \$130...they come up fairly often there.
