You might look for an late-70's Technics direct-drive turntable in good shape. They don't cost much at all on eBay and they sound pretty good. You could step up to Rega or a VPI, but those cost more. There is also the BIX turntable kit. But if you want to keep under \$500 or so, I'd get a good used Technics table. You'll be able to get the turntable for just a couple hundred bucks and that will allow you to spend the rest on a good cartridge.
