Since you ask; I would save and wait while using the Pioneer. Then when you have a little more cash; go with one of the 1k rigs. They are pretty much the breaking price point at which you get a significant improvement in detail retrieval/bass reproduction/high freq extension. Pretty much the whole sound opens up. At that point you are beating CD in terms of involving musical playback. There are plenty of that price around; check Audionote, their stuff is excellent.
