All the other insulation is glued in place, including the piece across the brace. Will this make any difference? Do I need to pull it off and glue a piece to the correct side?

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Go ahead and remove it and attach to the side nearest the port. It will peel away easily. Might leave a trace of fibers and glue lines - which might kind of "bug you" to know it's there - but that won't hurt anything and it'll stop bugging you in days. Especially after you give 'em your first audition with your favorite music.
