Hi there,I have a set of Bill's 800Hz Woodhorns with the PSD-2002 drivers and I'm looking to build a suitable set of woofers to match. Any suggestions on an SET friendly driver? I'm thinking something in a 12" size. The room is about 1400ft<sup>3</sup> and going much below 40Hz is probably not needed. I'd like to keep the box under 3ft<sup>3</sup> or so. Listening levels are generally on the lower side so I'd like to build something that doesn't need to be cranked to sound good.Any suggestions are appreciated.Thanks.DaveJ
