If 18g. sounds a little thin to you, double it for 15g.I had some old Audioquest speaker cable conductors and used those in 2 sizes to wire mine. That can be seen in this pic.

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If you want something better than zip cord but not costing too much, try Blue Jeans cables 12 ga Belden wire at 38 cents/ft. It's a two conductor, and there's an internal fiberglass thread that makes it easy to unzip to separate conductors.
