I want a ribbon buy, I am afraid of it sounding to bright and tizzie. I have read a lot about people doing up grades to them. I love theplanners but, I am afraid again not as much detail or aryieness asthe ribbons. I also need a good midrange looking at the accuton drivers very well made and uncolored.
