For hi-fi amp, the solution is easy - get at least "Auricaps", if not "Mundorf-Supreme", Russian teflons, some POI caps, etc. But for the guitar amp, owner needs some kind of "subjective sound" from his amp (rarely transparent, hi-fi sound :-)), and the only way to find out what you like more is to sacrifice a few \$, buy both and try them...

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
