But I am going to tool up when the sales at Father's Day get cooking. That piece from a few months ago where the guy uses the Rotozip for all the shaping is going to be my guide on these little guys. Lastly, just looking at them, I toyed with the idea of leaving the bottom open, putting some spikes or something on and putting them atop a couple marble tiles which are available at the home stores.
