I bought four cheap multiple secondary toroids some time ago, one shorted (primary) after about an hour, and then today I burned another one (primary too)...people who made them don't know what they are doing, for sure. Before you start to complain that maybe hurry and wire-mess, and cheap parts aren't the best way - please remember your faults...
