This consists of a pair each of: Delta 15A, PSD2002S, PXB2-1k6 crossover with hf comp, Peavey CH3 horn flare. These have been in and out of several enclosures and are in good shape. Right now they're in little enclosures tuned to about 150 hz that I was using as tops in a biamped system. Price is \$300 for components, \$50 for boxes, plus shipping from zipcode 01035. The Theater 4 with this driver set is very sensitive and tube friendly, and will go quite loud with a watt or less.
