I've got around \$275 invested in building them FWIW, not including any labor time or such of course. This is the amp Akhilesh listened to at GPAF. Specs include: original group buy board from DIY forumsopa551 buffersRaytheon 12FK6 tubesKiwame resistors (output still has a metal film in it, but have Kiwames for them)Cerafines on the output capsWima film capsTREAD regulated with wallwartAlps Blue Velvet potNeutrik locking jackbamboo/zebrawood/aluminum casingAlps Rko97 pot/switch combo as the power switch. There are tube sockets soldered to the board as well as the ones mounted to the aluminum strip if you would like to put a clear top on it. Cross clone is air wired - it looks a tad messy I knowJan's recommended Lorlin switchesStackpole and Radioshack carbon film resistorsWima film capson/off/on switch
