These are made to be used with the Altec series of 1.4" compression drivers. They are coated with "Aquaplas" to reduce ringing and dispersion is 45 x 60 degree pattern. These are heavy and large so shipping will not be cheap, in fact i would prefer a local pickup from Columbus, Ohio.
